





Study Overview:

- The pandemic has had a major impact on the health and well-being of residents, their families, and team members. In fact, most COVID-19 deaths in Canada have occurred in residents of care homes (e.g. long-term care & assisted living) and retirement homes.
- Our goal is to understand how vaccines can help keep residents safe and healthy so that we can get back to the way things used to be sooner.
- Over 1100 residents from 25 homes across Ontario are helping us with this research.
- Together, we are fighting COVID-19!



What we've learned so far and why it matters



Waning Immunity

The effect of the 3rd dose of the COVID-19 vaccine begins to wane after 3 months.



Omicron Variant

Omicron is highly transmissible & can cause infections even in vaccinated individuals. A 4th dose may help prevent severe illness.



Protect Others

Being vaccinated will help protect our most vulnerable population.

This is why it's important to get the 4th dose



Study Facts

COVID-19 Saliva Surveillance Testing:

We invited visitors, team members and residents from 18 homes to submit saliva samples weekly. These samples were used to identify COVID-19 infections, much like the rapid tests now. Over 3500 samples were collected over 33 weeks! This portion of the study is now complete.

What Were the Saliva Findings?

No COVID-19 infections were identified through the saliva testing! 🛵 What does this mean?


- This means that all participants were negative for COVID-19 at the time of testing.
- Rapid testing is working great as a COVID-19 screeing tool.
