

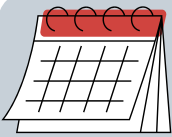

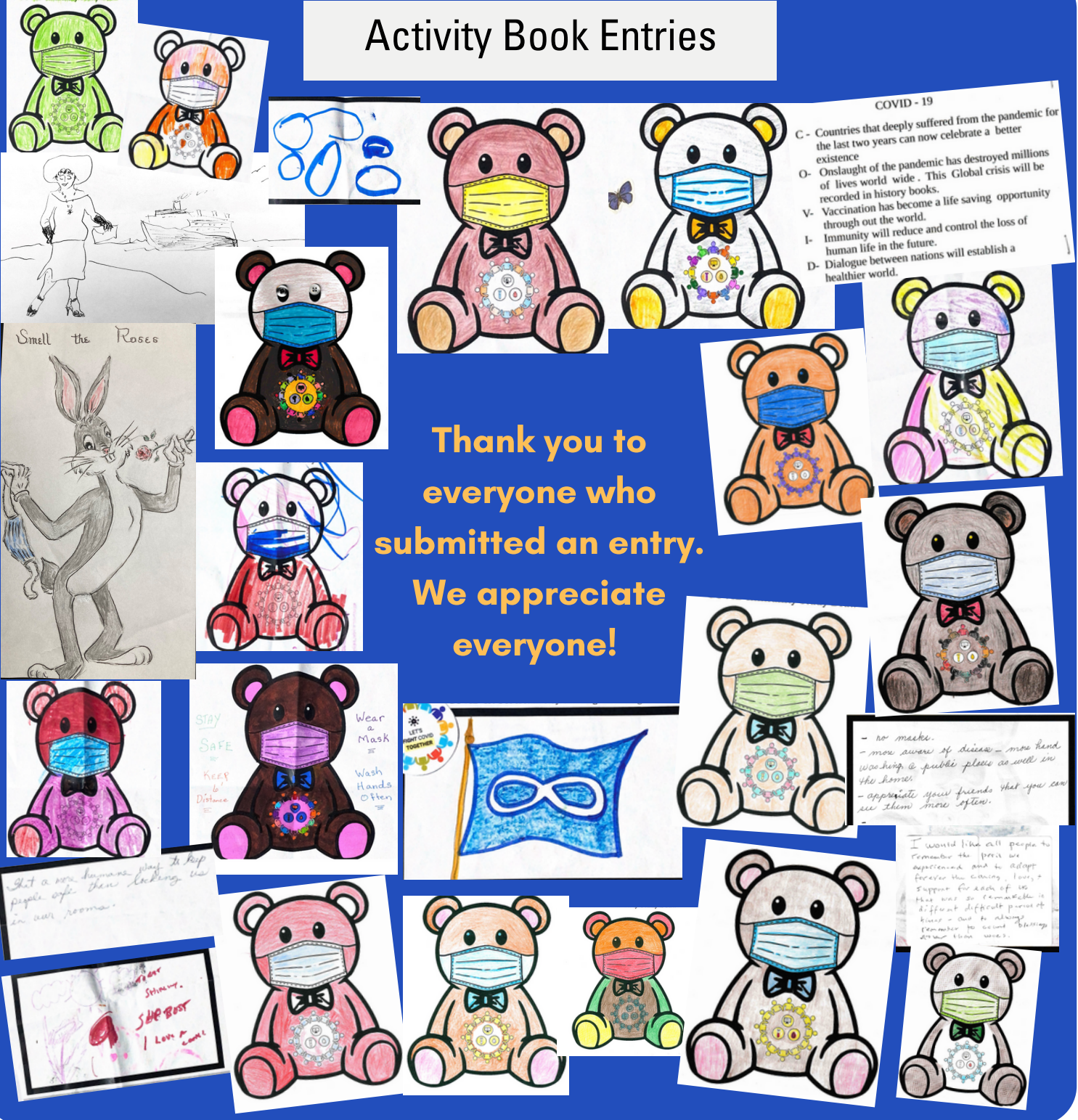


Bruce Seebach Resident at The Village of Winston Park
