"I wanted to help stop this dreadful virus that's going around and spreading. I feel honoured to be asked to join the study and anything I can do to help is a plus."




What is the Omicron Variant



Viruses often mutate over time, which means their DNA and infectious properties change.

Omicron is a version of the original COVID-19 virus.
Within Omicron, there are currently several different strains, such as the BA.4 and BA.5 viruses. Researchers



continue to identify new strains as the virus continues to mutate.

Omicron, especially BA.4 and BA.5, may be more infectious but less deadly than the original COVID-19 virus.

While the first vaccines were designed for the original COVID-19 strain, they still work against Omicron. When it comes to variants, vaccines appear to provide more protection against death and serious illness than infection.

Staying up to date on your vaccines is one of the best ways to stay protected against Omicron!
